#### Monday, August 23 Opening Keynote



Paul E. Clayton is known nationally for his work in motivation training for business professionals, teachers, government workers and support staff. His comic style is both informational and fun. He received his bachelor's degree in Philosophy and English. He has done graduate work at St. Mary's

University in Baltimore, MD. Paul spent nine years teaching secondary school.

Mr. Clayton developed and headed the Job Search Program at the Employment and Training Center, Camden County, NJ. He later became Executive Director of the Private Industry Council of Camden County, NJ. Mr. Clayton has been lauded for his non-traditional approach to motivation.

Mr. Clayton espouses the idea that skills training are not the best way to help people get motivated. His workshops are fun and informational.
