SNS Preparedness Course

Course Goals / Objectives: The Strategic National Stockpile Preparedness Course is designed to provide information and train federal, state, and local planners and officials on how to best use and manage the Strategic National Stockpile in response to a terrorist attack, natural disaster, or technological accident.

Description: The course provides participants with information on DSNS' levels of support, response concepts, and planning and operational considerations for receiving, staging, and storing SNS assets. Covered in depth are planning considerations for medical countermeasure dispensing campaigns with regulator information about labeling, Investigational New Drug (IND) operations, the course addresses POD site selection, set up, security, volunteer staffing, and public information and communications.

Size: Class size is limited to 35 students.

State Requirements:

- Approve student travel at least 21 days prior to start of course.

Student Requirements:

- Students should be in a planning or management position with public health, emergency management, or public safety.
- Should have some familiarity with the Strategic National Stockpile
