Our Houston, Fort Bend/Harris Counties jurisdiction received an EFSP Phase 28 Texas State Set-Aside (SSA) award. The EFSP Local Board (Local Board) has allocated the funds to LROs that received an initial Phase 28 award. The SSA funds are subject to the same requirements as reflected in the March 2009 EFSP Phase 28 Award Letter. The following indicates SSA Phase 28 support and total Phase 28 support for program(s) conducted by Fort Bend County Social Services in Fort Bend County for Phase 28 categories:


The amounts listed above are restricted for use in the respective categories to which they have been awarded. Any reallocation of these funds among categories requires prior written approval from the Local Board. The Local Board has the authority to reallocate funds during the program year to meet the needs of the community.

Reports on Phase 28 expenditures will be required from your agency for monitoring purposes. The Local Board will monitor expenditures and program performance of LROs during the Phase 28 funding period.

The National Board has been notified of the SSA awards. Payment of the SSA awards should be included with the Phase 28 second payment. Each LRO must **expend all EFSP Phase 28 funds by September 30, 2010.**


