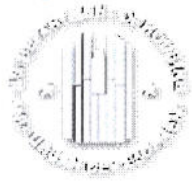

Description: HUD is pleased to announce its Green Building Regional Workshop series. The workshops are designed for all NSP grantees and their affiliates who carry out NSP redevelopment activities. Those who attend will receive guidance on green construction and rehabilitation techniques to support NSP activities being implemented at the neighborhood level and advance the energy efficiency sustainable design goals being pursued in a given community. Enterprise Community Partners is providing nine (9) Green Building Regional Workshops in the following locations-- Washington DC, Atlanta, New Orleans, Portland, Boston, Los Angeles, P Minneapolis, and Cleveland. The workshops are open to all NSP grantees and their affiliates--at no cost--as part of HUD's technical assistance effort. Participants need only pay any related travel. The workshop content will vary based on Climate Zone, so please choose a workshop location appropriate for your climate zone.
