Dear Mr. Ring,

On June, 15 we signed contracts.

We kicked off the project before the ink was dry on paperwork. The surveyors and geotech subs were on site busily working when I made a site visit on June 28. We had a very productive meeting with all the assembled staff of City of Richmond on June 22. We outlined the traffic scheme and talked about the utility challenges. The atmosphere was cordial and cooperative. Subsequently, the CoR PW dept marked their lines in the field with blue and green paint so our surveyors could locate and log for the SUE. We did the rounds with three County Commissioners to discuss the project and deliver intersection sketch.

Murphy and Amani Engineers who are doing the Traffic Warrant study met with Jim Hunt on July 1, at his office. He did not like the concept at all and wants major changes.
