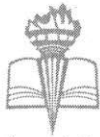

The Financial Transactions section and the Fraud Prevention and Deterrence sections of the exam will be offered on Thursday afternoon from 1:00 p.m. until 6:30 p.m. During this time, attendees may also take or retake other sections of the exam as needed. All exams must be turned in by 6:30 p.m.

Taking the exam on-site is optional.

The exam is only for course attendees and will be administered in written form. The on-site exam follows the same format as the electronic exam: 125 questions per section. There are four sections, and you may take the sections in any order you wish. You will read the questions and mark your answers on a Scantron answer sheet. An ACFE staff member will grade the tests on-site, providing your results for each section within a few minutes.

### **Retaking Sections**

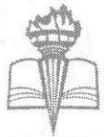
If you fail a section of the exam, you may retake it. Additionally, some of the course instructors will be available to answer any questions you have before you retake a section. If you pass one or more of the sections on-site, but not all four, you may retake the failed section(s) at a later date on your computer.

### **Passing the Exam**

If you pass all four sections, you will receive a personalized letter confirming your achievement and your certificate will be mailed to you within 2 to 3 weeks.

Passing the exam does not mean that you are certified or eligible to use the CFE credential until your CFE Exam application has been submitted and approved by the ACFE certification team.

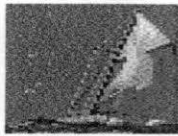

## On-Site Exam Format and Times

Attendees of the class may take the exam at several times during the week. The on-site exam is only for course attendees and will be administered in written form. The on-site exam follows the same format as the electronic exam: 125 questions per section. You will read the questions and mark your answers on a Scantron answer sheet. An ACFE staff member will grade the tests on-site, providing your results for each section within a few minutes.

The Investigation section of the exam is offered on Tuesday evening from 5:00 until 6:30 p.m. All exams must be turned in by 6:30 p.m.

The Law section of the exam is offered on Wednesday evening from 5:00 until 6:30 p.m. All exams must be turned in by 6:30 p.m.
