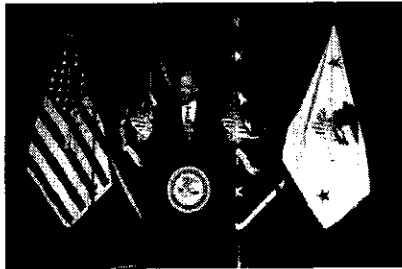

Pre-Event Workshops: April 16, 2012

This annual national training event (known as the ICAC National Conference in previous years) is designed to provide training to combat the online exploitation of children. It brings federal, state and local law enforcement investigators, forensic experts and prosecutors together to participate in workshops to further their knowledge, while providing them with the tools necessary to combat technology-facilitated crimes against children.

In 2011, the event attracted nearly 1,300 attendees from across the United States and around the world. *(View the highlights of the 2011 Conference).* These individuals took part in 290 **lecture and lab sessions**, with topics ranging from investigative techniques, legal procedure, and predator behavioral analysis. In addition, the networking that took place both within and outside our planned agenda provided an opportunity to establish the personal relationships necessary for a successful national interagency initiative.

The 2012 training promises to be even more exciting. Please join us in the fight against child exploitation.
