On Wednesday, September 12, 2012, I was advised that there was an issue concerning a gas/fuel receipt turned in to the barn on Monday, August 27, 2012.

On August 20, 2012 through August 24, 2012, I attend a federal examiner's course (Continuing Education) at 1200 Travis Street; Downtown Houston and Houston Police Department. In order to maintain enough fuel to travel back and forth, I fueled my county vehicle utilizing my issued gas card. My history will show that the only time my fuel card has been utilized was in conjunction with official business and traveling. I routine travel to and from work in my county vehicle traveling approximately 17 miles one way and 34 miles round trip. Traveling to Houston Police Department for training is approximately 23.39 miles one way and 47.8 miles round trip and approximately 239 miles for 5 days of training.

The previous week, I did not work a full 5 day schedule; therefore did not fuel my county vehicle. To ensure I had enough fuel I utilized my county fuel card and fueled my county vehicle. Upon return to work on August 27, 2012, I fuel my county vehicle at the county fuel pumps as usual.
