

AGENCY AGREEMENT

This LeadsOnline, Inc. AGENCY AGREEMENT ("Agreement"), is made between Fort Bond Country, Texas, a a body corporate and politic, acting herein by and through its Purchasing Agent, according to V.T.C.A local Government Code 262.011(d), for the benefit of the fort Bend Country Shortiff's Office ("Principal") and LeadsOnline LLC ("Provider").



- Provider agrees to provide Principal's designated Department Head with a monthly report detailing the usage of Provider's web site by Principal's Authorized Officials, which includes the number of searches by each Authorized Official, properly searched, names of suspects searched, along with Principal's case numbers associated with those searches.

V. CONDITIONS FOR PRINCIPAL'S ACCESS AND USE OF PROVIDER'S WES SITE


