Audience:

This is an introductory level course. The content is geared for people with little or no experience using the NTD reporting system.

The NTD Classroom sessions are primarily intended for anyone who is new to NTD Reporting, and who has not previously attended an NTD Classroom Session. This two-day course covers all aspects of completing a full NTD Report, from the perspective of someone who is unfamiliar with NTD reporting. If your system is planning on requesting a Small Systems Waiver, you should <u>not</u> sign up for this course, as most of the material will not be relevant to you. Additionally, anyone covered by the Rural NTD Reporting System should <u>not</u> sign up for this course. Finally, Safety & Security reporting is <u>not</u> covered in this course, but is covered by a separate webinar.


