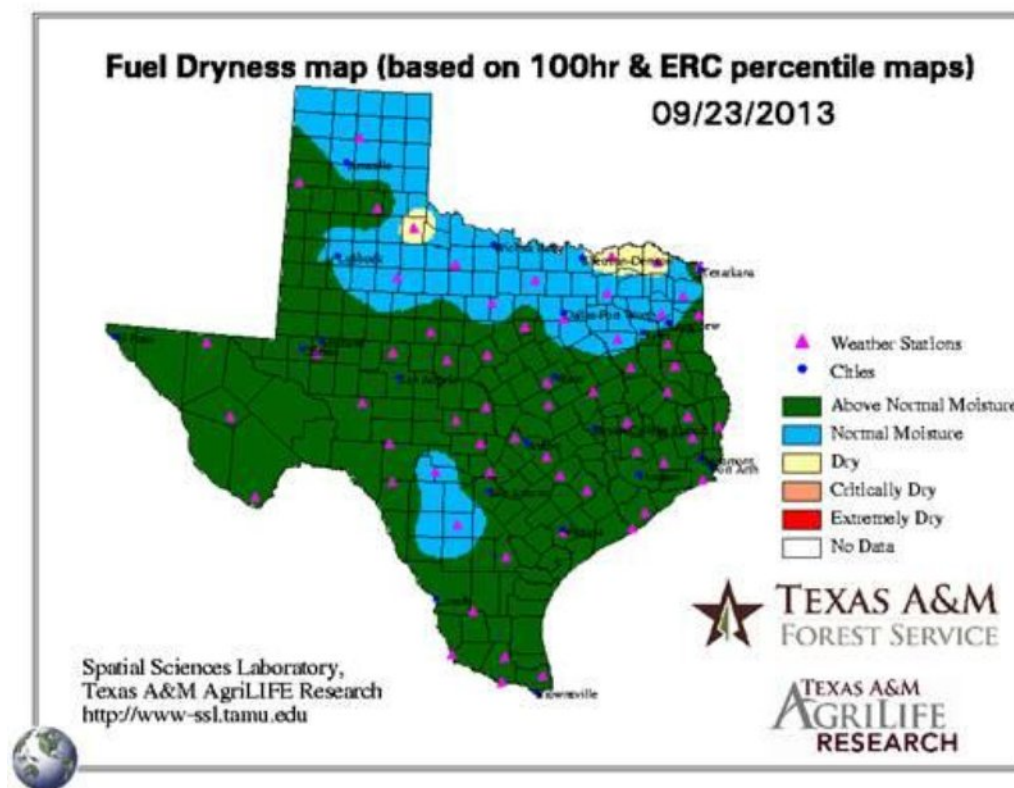

Fort Bend County currently has an average KBDI of 364.

The attached Seasonal Energy Release Component (ERC) graph ([http://ticc.tamu.edu/Documents/PredictiveServices/Fuels/erc\\_map.htm](http://ticc.tamu.edu/Documents/PredictiveServices/Fuels/erc_map.htm)) demonstrates a low ERC for the Upper Gulf Coast Region consisting of Brazoria, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Jackson, Jefferson, Matagorda, Orange and Wharton Counties.

Today's Observed Fuel Moisture map also depicts Fort Bend County having Above Normal Moisture.
