## 2013 UASI Sub-Recipient

- 1. Regional Communications Preparedness and Awareness Project (\$223,192)
  - a. The continuation of 2 grant funded salaries and the CERT community outreach program
- 2. Regional Planners (\$217,085)
  - a. The continuation of 2.5 grant funded salaries as well as training, conferences, and travel expenditures
- 3. Sustainment of Critical EOC Technologies (\$179,296)
  - a. The continuation of 1 grant funded salary (Pier) plus software maintenance and satellite service, etc.
- 4. Fort Bend Haz-Mat/CBRNE (\$186,050)
  - a. The sustainment and enhancement of the Fort Bend Haz-Mat/CBRNE team to include training and equipment
- 5. Fort Bend Technical Rescue Project (\$240,100)
  - a. The sustainment and enhancement of the Fort Bend Technical Rescue team to include training and equipment
- 6. Mortuary Rack and Tray System (\$55,000)
  - a. This project is to enhance the regions capability to respond to a mass fatality incident (i.e. plane crash)
- 7. EOC Consolette and Subscriber Unit Upgrade (\$608,400)
  - a. This project is to upgrade end-of-life and failing radio equipment in the EOC and to replace/upgrade Sheriff's Office portable radios
