Notice of Public Meeting US 59: from Spur 10 to SH 99

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a public meeting on the proposed widening of US 59 from Spur 10 to SH 99, in Fort Bend County, Texas. The meeting will be conducted on Tuesday, January 21, 2014, in the cafeteria of George Junior High School, 4601 Airport Avenue, Rosenberg, Texas 77471.

The purpose of the meeting is to present design changes that have resulted from the public hearing held on May 16, 2013, as well as gather public input on these changes.

DESIGN CHANGES - The interchanges at FM 762 and Reading Road would be reversed from the existing condition and May 2013 proposed design. US 59 mainlanes are now proposed to go over these roadways. Ramp changes would also occur in conjunction with the interchange redesign. At FM 762, a new access road connecting the park & ride facilities on the north and south sides of US 59 would also be constructed. The project's additional right-of-way requirements have been reduced from approximately 54.95 acres to 47.98 acres and would now require no displacements.

The meeting will be structured in an Open House format, and exhibits will be displayed for viewing from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. Representatives from TxDOT and the project study team will be available to answer individual questions. Public comments are encouraged. No formal presentation will be made. Information regarding this project is on file and available for viewing at TxDOT's Houston District Office, 7600 Washington Avenue, Houston, Texas 77007, and at TxDOT's Fort Bend Area Office, 4235 SH 36, Rosenberg, Texas 77471.

All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting. Persons interested in attending the meeting that have special communication or accommodation needs are encouraged to contact the District Public Information Officer at (713) 802-5072 at least two working days before the meeting. The public meeting will be conducted in English. Requests for language interpreters or other special communication needs should be made at least two working days before the public meeting. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs. The TxDOT office is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, excluding state holidays.
