RE: Speed Study - Harlem Road

Dear Commissioner:

Fort Bend County Engineering has completed a speed study for the above referenced roadway facility. The purpose of this study was to determine if the current speed limit of 45 mph can be reasonably and safely raised to 50 mph. The study was conducted from July 8th to 11th 2014 using pneumatic tube counters to collect the speed data of the vehicular traffic.

Harlem Road is a five (5) lane Major Thoroughfare with a two way left turn lane and no sidewalks. The data collected showed the 85th percentile speed on Harlem Road is 50 mph. We recommend changing the speed limit to the 85th percentile speed of 50 mph.
