THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 19<sup>th</sup> day of November 2014, and modifies the VIOLATION PROCESSING SERVICES AGREEMENT effective 17, 2013 (the "Agreement") by and between the Fort Bend Grand Parkway Toll Road Authority, a Texas Local Government Corporation (the "Authority"), and Xerox State & Local Solutions, Inc., a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York (herein called "Xerox").

The Agreement is hereby modified as follows:

1. In accordance with Section 1.02 of the Agreement, the Authority and Xerox approve the change order attached hereto, which shall be included in the Agreement as **Exhibit I**.

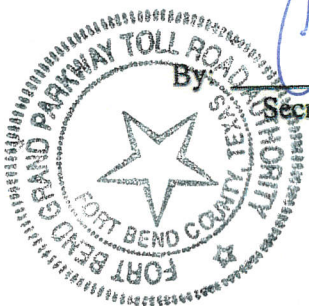

Xerox is pleased to present the FBCTRA with the cost proposal associated with the effort required to modify our current business rules to allow an escalation threshold for a Toll Violation Notice (TVN).

The price to support the TVN Escalation Threshold software change is US \$14,257.00. The TVN Escalation Threshold software modification will create a configurable parameter \$ value. An unpaid TVN having an outstanding balance greater the \$ parameter set by Fort Bend will be sent to collections. A TVN with a total value less than the \$ parameter will be held from escalating to collections. The current parameter threshold will be set at \$24.00.
