PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION PROGRAM SPECIAL SESSION AUBURN HOTEL & CONFERENCE CENTER

- For this session, you may choose from one to four courses to attend at a reduced price for the Election Center's Professional Education Program. Completion of this program leads to certification as a Certified Elections/Registration Administrator (CERA), Vendor (CERV) or Monitor (CEM). Due to enrollment limitations, only paid reservations will be honored. This is your opportunity to accelerate your progress through the courses and/or to allow you to complete your course requirements.
- In order to give as many people as possible an opportunity to take several courses at one location, we have contracted with the Auburn Hotel and Conference Center to keep the cost at its lowest possible rate. The classes will still be the same high quality instruction but in a "no frills" atmosphere. No meals will be provided. You will need to supply your own notepads, paper, pencils, etc. If you are able to, please bring a laptop computer to the classes with you. We use the laptops for group presentations in lieu of flip charts.
- All classes require full class attendance. In order to receive credit from Auburn University and The Election Center, students <u>must</u> attend the total class hours. ANY absence from the class will result in no credit given for that particular course. You must schedule your travel arrangements--arrival and departure--so you can participate in the FULL class hours. If you must handle on-going office business while at the session, you need to handle that before class, during the lunch time [from noon to 1:30 p.m.] or after class. Cell phones, pagers, and any other electronic devices cannot be active during class. If you arrive late or depart early, YOU WILL NOT receive credit for the class and you will not receive a refund. This includes flights home so book flights well after ending time of courses. Do NOT plan on leaving class early to catch a flight. Please pay attention to all class times as they may vary.
- This is a serious, academically oriented Professional Education Program. As such, you are expected to be prepared as you would be in any other academic situation. Suggested attire is business casual. Keep a copy of this notice -- no other materials will be sent.
