This memorandum is to summarize activities conducted on the Fort Bend County (client) Mobility Projects during the month of March 2015. Below are tasks with short descriptions in which employees provided support.

- Williams Way Environmental – Staff ecologists continue to coordinate with the project team to address environmental concerns. A meeting was attended with the Commissioner and project team to identify alternative routes to avoid an existing cemetery. Based on the results of this meeting, an environmental site visit was conducted along a newly-proposed road alignment to identify any other environmental concerns. Coordination with the Texas Historical Commission continued to identify minimal buffer necessary.
- Administration – Provided support to project manager including contractual support, billing oversight and meeting coordination.
