

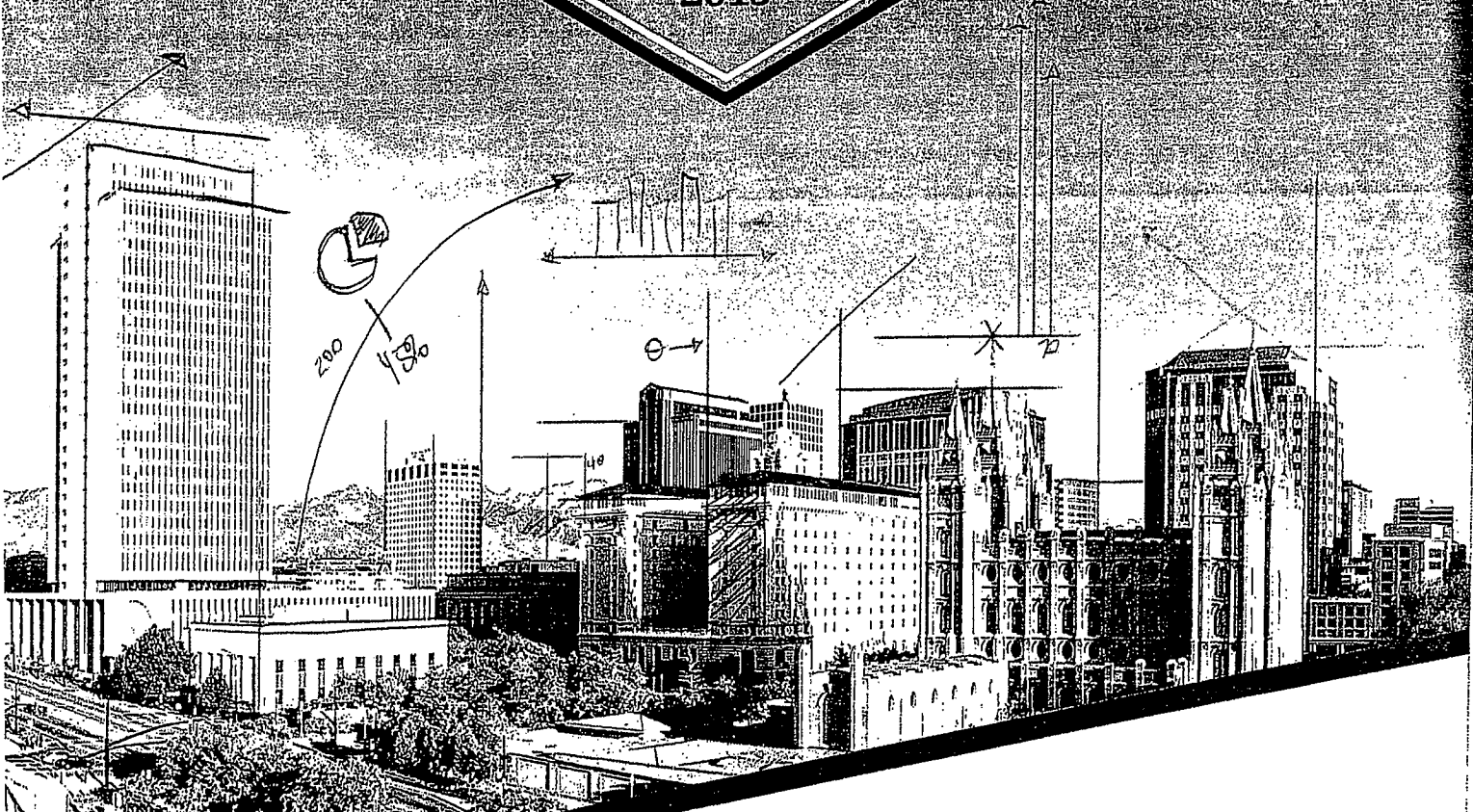

NACCED's 40th Annual Community and Economic Development Conference and Training in Salt Lake County, Utah provides valuable educational and networking opportunities to a diverse range of affordable housing and community and economic development practitioners from the public and private sectors. This year's conference theme is "Defining the Future" and we expect a national audience of housing, community and economic development professionals from all levels of federal, state and local government, as well as community-based and nonprofit organizations.

Salt Lake County serves as host for NACCED's 40th Annual Conference. Salt Lake County is a diverse community with over a million residents and is comprised of 16 cities and six townships, including the largest city and state capital, Salt Lake City. As the "Crossroads of the West," Salt Lake has a rich and celebrated diversity where local residents and visitors alike enjoy exposure to a lengthy list of multi-cultural events and activities. Salt Lake offers something of interest for everyone: interactive activities for kids, symphony, ballet, theatre, sightseeing tours, history and art museums, river and outdoor expeditions, and fishing and wildlife experiences. Just to name a few!

Take in historic sites and points of interest by grabbing a GREENbike or taking a guided bike tour in downtown Salt Lake. History buffs can visit Temple Square or budding geologists can explore the Great Salt Lake. As home to the 2002 Winter Olympics, you can visit and play on many of the Olympic venues. Or, visit one of the 21 national parks and monuments or any of the 40 state parks that are all within just a few hours' drive of Salt Lake County.

Make sure to leave plenty of time for the conference sessions which will include fair housing compliance, revolving loan fund capitalization and management, succession planning, economic sustainability and disaster resiliency.
