Right of Entry for the Northern Regional Water Pipeline Project

Dear Property Owner:

The Brazosport Water Authority ("BWA") is a political subdivision of the State of Texas and wholesale potable water provider to cities and customers within Brazoria County and Fort Bend County. The mission of BWA is to produce and deliver a consistent and reliable supply of quality drinking water to member cities and contracted customers.

BWA is designing a new 40-mile water transmission pipeline that will provide treated drinking water to residents in Fort Bend County and Brazoria County. At this juncture, the proposed route of this underground water transmission pipeline includes the location of a water line on your property. As part of the design process, BWA is requesting access to your property to perform surveying, geotechnical evaluation, environmental studies, and sub-utility engineering required to be performed in order to construct the water transmission line and finalize the project. BWA has a clear legal right to enter onto your property for these limited purposes. Please let me know if we can coordinate this access with you so that any intrusion into the use of the property is minimized.
