Dear Mayor Thompson:

As you know, HB 2398 in the 84th legislature requires all counties with two or more courts hearing truancy cases and two or more school districts to appoint a committee to recommend uniform processes and procedures for truancy cases. This committee is to be appointed by the County Judge and the Mayor of the municipality within the county with the greatest population.

I have appointed the following in accordance with that requirement.

I understand that you will also be appointing members under each of the above categories to complete this committee, and the committee will take effect January 1, 2016. Please reply as soon as possible with your list of appointees so that we may officially record the County Wide Truancy Policy Committee members by January 1st.
