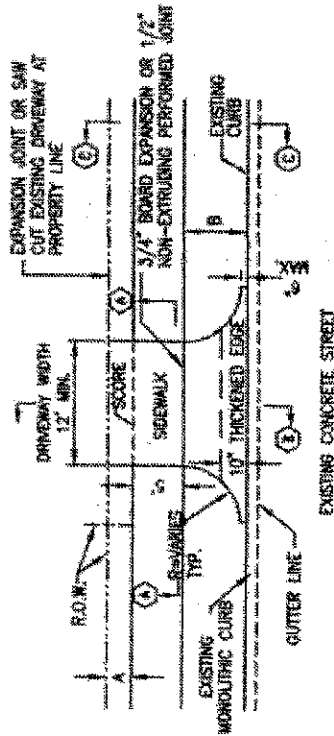

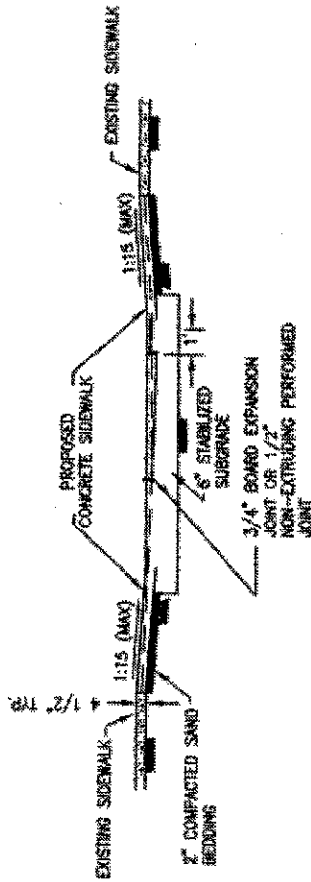

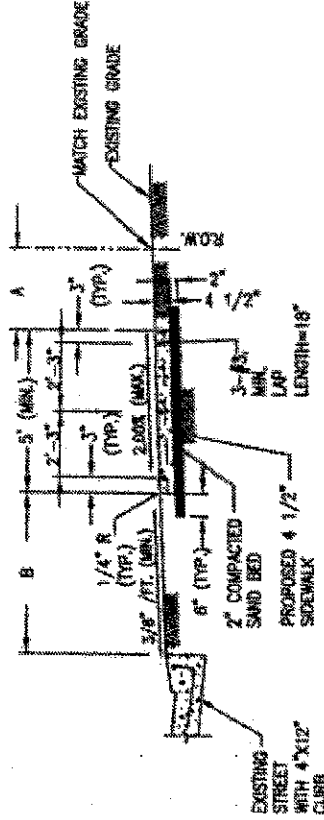
1. DRIVEWAYS AND SIDEWALKS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED WITH PORTLAND CEMENT CONCRETE AND INCLUDE 5 1/2 SACKS OF CEMENT PER CUBIC YARD OF CONCRETE.
2. THE OUTER DOWEL BARS ARE TO BE LOCATED 12" FROM END OF PROPOSED EDGE OF DRIVEWAY RETURN. EXTEND DOWEL 3" INTO PROPOSED DRIVEWAY AND BEND REMAINING BAR TO EXTEND RADIUS RETURN BOTH SIDES.
3. TROWEL GROOVE SEALANT SHALL BE LOW MODULUS SILICONE OR POLYURETHANE SEALANT.
4. EXPANSION AND CONSTRUCTION JOINTS ALONG SIDEWALK SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE TO DETAIL FOR EXPANSION AND CONSTRUCTION JOINTS.



PLAN VIEW -- DRIVEWAY



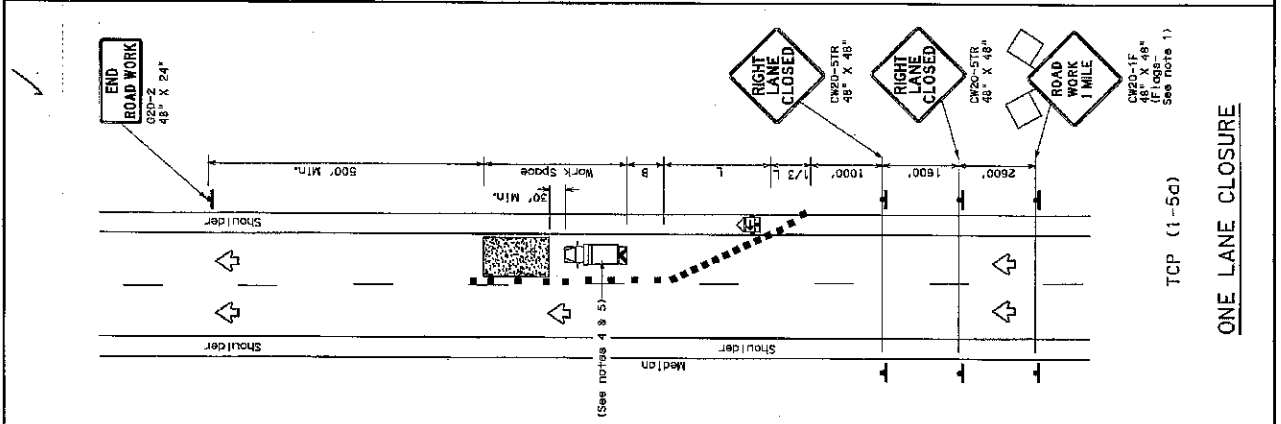

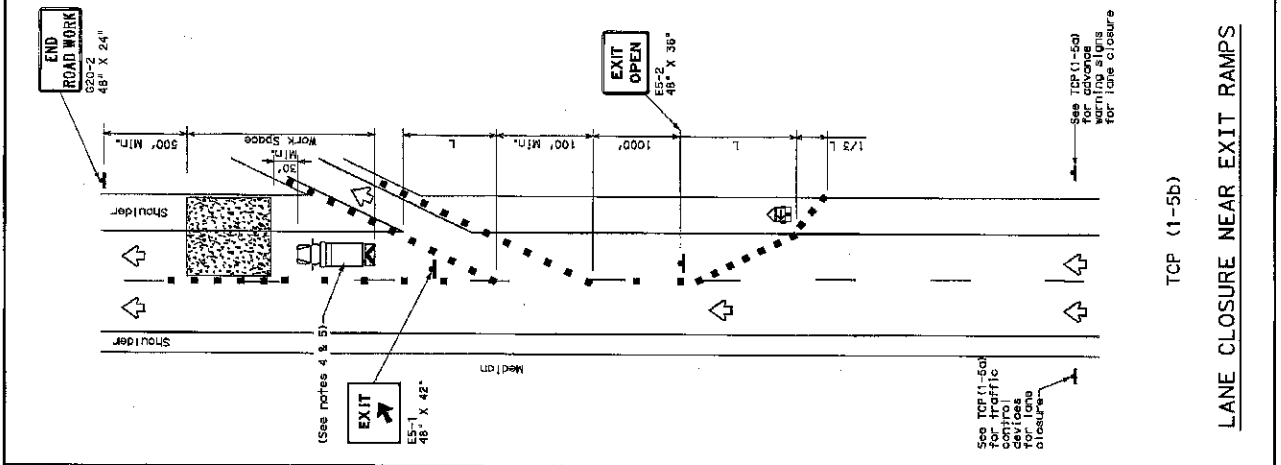
SECTION (C)

PROPOSED DRIVEWAY WITH SIDEWALK

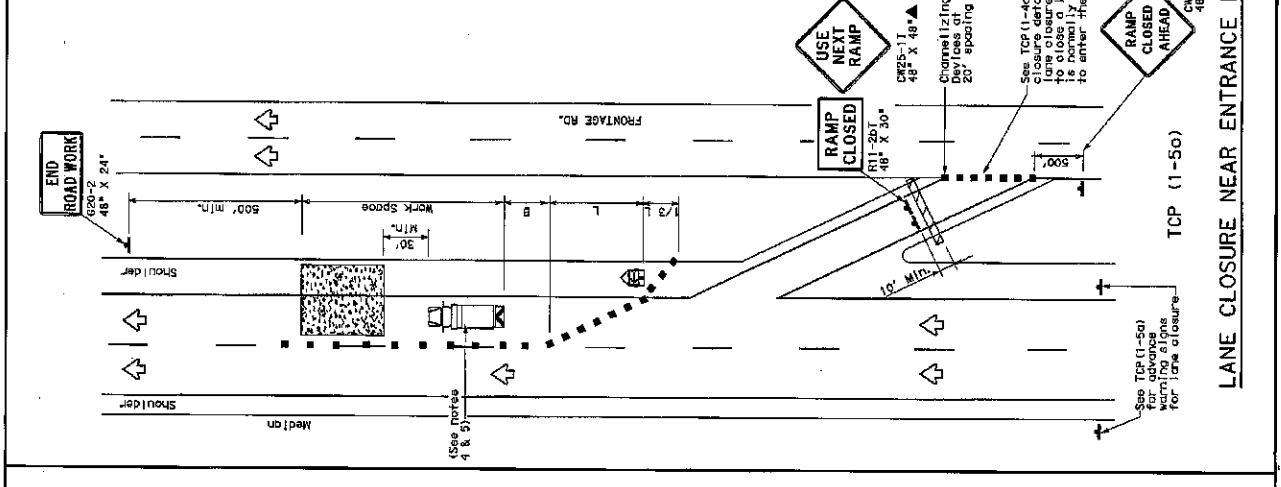

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GENERAL NOTES

- Flags attached to signs where shown, are REQUIRED.
- All traffic control devices illustrated are REQUIRED, except those denoted with the triangle symbol may be omitted when stored elsewhere.
- Channelizing devices used to close lanes may be supplemented with Chevron Alignment Sign placed on every other channelizing device. Chevrons may be attached to plastic drums as per AC Standards.
- Shovel vehicles with AM and high intensity rotating, flashing, or strobe lights may be used to supplement channelizing devices. The use of any type of work exposure without adversely affecting the performance or quality of the work. If workers are no longer present but road or work conditions require the traffic control to remain in place, Type 3 Barricades or other channelizing devices may be substituted for the additional Shovel vehicles with TMS may be positioned in each closed lane, on the shoulder or off the paved surface, next to those shown in order to protect a wider work space.

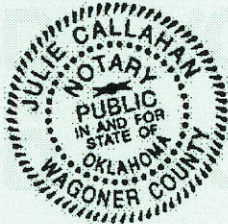
