Article 2.132(b) CCP Law Enforcement Policy on Racial Profiling

FORT BEND CO. CONST. PCT. 2 has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- (1) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- (2) strictly prohibit peace officers employed by the FORT BEND CO. CONST. PCT. 2 from engaging in racial profiling;
- (3) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the FORT BEND CO. CONST. PCT. 2 if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the FORT BEND CO. CONST. PCT. 2 has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- (4) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- (5) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the FORT BEND CO. CONST. PCT. 2 who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the FORT BEND CO. CONST. PCT. 2's policy adopted under this article;
- (6) require collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
 - (A) the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
 - (B) whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search; and

(C) whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual; and

(7) require the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision (6) to:

(A) the Commission on Law Enforcement; and

(B) the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.

FORT BEND COUNTY PRECINCT 2 CONSTABLE'S OFFICE 2015 RACIAL PROFILING REPORT-ANALYSIS

PURPOSE:

In accordance with the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 2.133, our Office has conducted an analysis of all traffic stops from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015 to ensure there was no racial profiling committed by any sworn officer commissioned by this Office.

After a review of all data, we did not find any evidence that profiling was committed during 2015. The quantitative results are listed in this report.

DEMOGRAPHICS OF FORT BEND COUNTY:

According to the 2010 United States Census, the population of Fort Bend County is 585,375. Of that population, 138,967 are listed as Hispanic or Latino and 446,408 are listed as non-Hispanic or Latino. Other demographics of Fort Bend County include:

There were a total of 715 traffic stops conducted in 2015 by this agency. All stops were recorded by either a written warning or a written citation for the offense(s) committed.
