TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **Location:** The attached map and inventory indicates the location and type of surplus property to be removed.
2. **Time Period:** The Political Subdivision has one year from date of approval to initiate relocation of the trees or the acquisition may not be made. Work will not interfere in any way with any highway contract construction or repair work, or any State maintenance work that may be done on this road. In the event that such interference occurs, you will cease operations in the area involved until such time as the roadwork referred to above is completed.
3. **Right of Access:** The State grants the Political Subdivision or its authorized representative(s) access to the site to perform any activities required to execute the work. The project shall not damage any part of the highway, and adequate provisions must be made to cause minimum inconvenience to traffic and adjacent property owners.
4. **Traffic Control:** The Political Subdivision must provide adequate traffic control necessary to protect the safety of the traveling public. A traffic control plan must be approved by the Area Engineer. No work within State right-of-way can begin until this approval has been given.
5. **Utilities:** The Political Subdivision must verify all utilities within project area. Utility considerations include, but are not limited to the following: gas, water, electricity, fiber optics, telephone, signals, lighting, CTMS, sanitary sewer, etc.
6. **Costs:** All costs to move the surplus property will be borne by the Political Subdivision.
7. **Responsibilities of the Parties:** The Political Subdivision acknowledges that will it is not an agent, servant, nor employee of the State, it is responsible for its own acts and deeds and for those of its agent(s), or employees during the performance of the work on the Project and shall provide all labor, equipment, material and incidentals as may be required to repair or replace equipment, structures or surfaces damaged by the Political Subdivision or its agent(s) or contractor(s) during the execution of this work. The Political Subdivision shall not be obligated to relocate the entire number trees reflected in the Description of Surplus Property above.
