I am writing to request a variance to the county requirement to install a sidewalk along Brentford Drive adjacent to the above referenced project. The subject property is located at the southwest corner of Beechnut Street and Brentford Drive in Fort Bend County. It is also located adjacent to an existing single family neighborhood called Chelsea. The development plans for the proposed apartments have been reviewed and approved by Fort Bend County, and the project is currently under construction.

Brentford Drive is lined on both sides by mature oak trees within the right of way. The adjacent neighborhood homeowner's association has expressed a desire for the trees to remain in place and not be removed for installation of a sidewalk along the new apartment project. The desire of the apartment developer is to be good neighbors to the existing development and to also work with Fort Bend County to save the existing mature trees.

Therefore, on behalf of the apartment developer, I would like to request a variance to the Fort Bend County requirement to install sidewalks along Brentford Drive in order to save existing the trees.
