<b>Item</b>	<b>Cost</b>	<b>Explanation</b>
Purchase of K-9 and K-9 Handler Training	\$6,500.00	Purchase of one fully trained accelerant detection canine from Houston K-9 Academy. This purchase price also includes 4 weeks of canine handler training.
Elite K-9 Patrol ID Harness	\$69.95	when the K-9 is working a scene. This device provides for more comfort for the K-9 and better control of the K-9 for the handler. The harness would have our agency patch on each side, with an ID panel underneath which would read POLICE.
Police K-9 ID Panels	\$29	ID panels to go onto the Patrol ID Harness. These panels would read POLICE
10 ft. Black nylon lead	\$22	This lead would be utilized with a neck collar for walking the dog when not actively working a scene. This lead would be utilized with a nylon neck collar.
Black Nylon ID Collar	\$29.95	Black 2 inch nylon collar. Collar has a velcro patch for an ID panel to be placed. Uses the same ID panel as the Patrol ID Harness.
ASAT Lead 20 ft long	\$29.95	This lead would be utilized with the Patrol ID Harness when actively working a scene. This lead allows the K-9 to extend out from the officer to perform its duty.
Buddy Bowls	\$42.00	Spill/splash-proof water bowl holds 64 ounces of water. Would be utilized in the vehicle K-9 transport kennel and in the office.
Ultra Scent Case with 12 Jars	\$150	Case is made of an ultra high impact reinforced nylon material and features stainless hinge pins, a silicon rubber O-ring to make the case air-tight and waterproof and a provision that can be locked. Case comes with : twelve (12) air-tight scent jars and a complete set of training aid labels.
Food/Rewards	\$250	Food and Rewards for the dog
Medical	\$600	Quarterly check-ups by the veterinarian, vaccinations, preventative medications, any minor medical treatments
Training expenses	\$250	Training expenses include training aids and materials, travel for re-certification training, and any other training related expenditure
CADA	\$50	Membership and Certification by Canine Accelerant Detection Association
NAPWDA	\$45	Membership and Certification by North American Police Work Dog Association
