The engineering group from Byer /AT&T finally contacted us this morning. We have no objection to this work as long as the following notes are placed on the plans:

Utility Permit Notes for work within FBGPTRA and FBCTRA (collectively as FBTRA) Right of Way

- \* All work must meet TxDOT / State of Texas utility accommodation requirements
- \* Notify Phil Martin with FBTRA at least 48 hours prior to commencing work at (713) 574-5261: philmartin@mikestoneassociates.com
- \* Utility owner must provide owner's responsible person's name and contact information (not contractor's contact information).
- \* Any work with in the toll road right of way requires a traffic control plan; even if lanes are not affected. TCP must meet TxDOT or TMUTCD requirements and be reviewed by FBTRA with no objections prior to starting work.
- \* Access to SH 99 or Fort Bend Parkway must be coordinated with Phil Martin prior to work.
- \* Bore pits within the right of way must be protected during non-work hours.
- \* Contractor must clean roadway of dirt and debris prior at the end of each work day or prior to opening roadway to traffic
- \* Peak hours are from 5am to 9am, and 3pm to 7pm. No lane closures permitted during peak hours without authorization from FBTRA.
- \* Work areas that have been disturbed must be returned to the original condition and may be required to place grass sod and continual watering.
- \* Upon completion of work, submit CADD/Microstation files and pdf of Record Drawings to Phil Martin with FBTRA.
