THIRD AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT, is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter "County"), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and Brown & Gay Engineers, Inc., (hereinafter "Contractor"), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the parties executed and accepted that certain Agreement for Professional Engineering Services on July 8, 2014, (hereinafter "Agreement") pursuant to SOQ 14-025, an Amendment to the Agreement on March 24, 2015, (hereinafter "First Amendment") to add geotechnical services; and an additional Amendment to the Agreement on June 23, 2015 (hereinafter "Second Amendment") to add surveying services; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to further amend the Agreement to add additional metes and bounds services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

- Services to be rendered under the Agreement shall be amended to add professional metes and bounds services, as described in the Proposal for Professional Services – Additional Services (Metes and Bounds) dated May 12, 2016, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein for purposes.
- 2. County shall pay Contractor an additional three thousand dollars and no/100 (\$3,000.00), on a lump sum basis, for the professional metes and bounds services to be rendered under this Third Amendment.
- 3. The Maximum Compensation payable to Contractor for Services rendered is hereby increased to an amount not to exceed one hundred sixty-seven thousand one hundred ten dollars and no/100 (\$170,110.00), allocated as follows:
 - A. \$150,000.00 under the Agreement;
 - B. \$11,110.00 under the First Amendment;
 - C. \$6,000.00 under the Second Amendment; and
 - D. \$3,000.00 under this Third Amendment.
- 4. In no case shall the amount paid by County for all Services under the Agreement, the First Amendment, Second Amendment and this Third Amendment exceed the Maximum Compensation without written agreement executed by the parties.

5. The time of performance for all Services to be provided by Contractor, including the additional services, shall be extended by twelve (12) months from the date of termination as provided in the Agreement.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged.
