WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas (the "County") deems it advisable to hold an election to ascertain whether the Commissioners Court shall be authorized to issue bonds of the County for construction of and improvements to park facilities, for construction of and improvements to the Fort Bend County fairgrounds, for construction and renovation of County libraries and for construction and improvements to County offices and facilities, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court wishes to proceed with the ordering of such election,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. All of the facts recited in the preamble hereof are hereby found and determined to be true and correct.

Section 2. An election shall be held in the County on the 3rd day of November, 2015, which is not less than fifteen (15) days nor more than ninety (90) days from the date hereof, in which all resident, qualified electors of the County shall be entitled to vote. The polls shall be open for voting at such election from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Voting shall be at the countywide polling places previously established by order of the Commissioners Court, and the election shall be conducted at each polling place by the officers previously appointed by order of the Commissioners Court. The list of countywide polling places is set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

Section 3. At the election the following PROPOSITIONS shall be submitted in accordance with law:

PROPOSITION ONE

SHALL THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE AND SELL AT ANY PRICE OR PRICES THE BONDS OF THE COUNTY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$ 9,900,000 MATURING SERIALLY OR OTHERWISE WITHIN 40 YEARS FROM THEIR DATE OR DATES, AND BEARING INTEREST AT SUCH RATE OR RATES, NOT TO EXCEED THE MAXIMUM INTEREST RATE NOW OR HEREAFTER AUTHORIZED BY LAW, AS SHALL BE DETERMINED WITHIN THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT AT THE TIME OF ISSUANCE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING LAND FOR AND PURCHASING, CONSTRUCTING, REPAIRING, EQUIPPING, FURNISHING,

LANDSCAPING AND IMPROVING PARK FACILITIES, COMMUNITY CENTERS AND OTHER RELATED IMPROVEMENTS AND FACILITIES REASONABLY REQUIRED IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, UTILITIES, PERSONAL PROPERTY AND PARKING FACILITIES TO BE USED FOR COUNTY PARK FACILITIES IN FORT BEND COUNTY AND TO LEVY TAXES UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE COUNTY ANNUALLY SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE INTEREST ON THE BONDS AS IT ACCRUES AND TO CREATE A SINKING FUND TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF THE BONDS AS IT MATURES, AS AUTHORIZED BY THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, INCLUDING THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE AND THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE?

SHALL THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE AND SELL AT ANY PRICE OR PRICES THE BONDS OF THE COUNTY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$ 62,900,000 MATURING SERIALLY OR OTHERWISE WITHIN 40 YEARS FROM THEIR DATE OR DATES, AND BEARING INTEREST AT SUCH RATE OR RATES, NOT TO EXCEED THE MAXIMUM INTEREST RATE NOW OR HEREAFTER AUTHORIZED BY LAW, AS SHALL BE DETERMINED WITHIN THE DISCRETION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT AT THE TIME OF ISSUANCE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING LAND AND FOR PURCHASING, CONSTRUCTING, REPAIRING, EQUIPPING, FURNISHING, LANDSCAPING AND IMPROVING BUILDINGS AND OTHER RELATED IMPROVEMENTS AND FACILITIES REASONABLY REQUIRED IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, UTILITIES, PERSONAL PROPERTY, AND COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT TO BE USED FOR COUNTY BUILDINGS FOR THE HOUSING OF COUNTY OR DISTRICT OFFICES, COUNTY OR DISTRICT COURTS, JUSTICE OF THE PEACE COURTS, LAW ENFORCEMENT AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FACILITIES, COUNTY RECORDS AND EQUIPMENT OR FOR CONDUCTING OTHER PUBLIC BUSINESS IN FORT BEND COUNTY AND TO LEVY TAXES UPON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE COUNTY ANNUALLY SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE INTEREST ON THE BONDS AS IT ACCRUES AND TO CREATE A SINKING FUND TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF THE BONDS AS IT MATURES, AS AUTHORIZED BY THE CONSTITUTION AND LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, INCLUDING THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE AND THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE?

Section 4. Section 6. In accordance with Texas Election Code, Section 3.009, the County currently estimates that, if the propositions contained herein were approved and the bonds proposed herein were authorized and issued, the County's ad valorem debt service tax rate is projected to be a maximum of approximately \$0.063 per \$100 of assessed valuation. The estimated tax rate is based on current assumptions and projections of interest rates, property development, assessed valuations and tax collection rates. To the extent that such assumptions and projects are not realized, the actual tax rate assessed by the County may vary substantially from the estimated tax rate. The estimated tax rate provided in this Section shall not be considered part of the bond propositions to be submitted to the voters pursuant to this Order and shall not be considered as a limitation on the County's authority to levy, assess and collect an ad valorem tax, within the limits prescribed by law.

<u>Section 7</u>. The aggregate amount of the outstanding principal of the County's bonds secured by ad valorem taxes as of the beginning of the County's fiscal year-ending September 30, 2015 is \$634,430,000.

<u>Section 8</u>. The aggregate amount of the outstanding interest on the County's bonds secured by ad valorem taxes as of the beginning of the County's fiscal year-ending September 30, 2015 is \$ 375,026,415.

<u>Section 9</u>. The debt service tax rate for the County as of the date of this order is \$0.06600 per \$100 valuation of taxable property.

Section 10. Notice of such election shall be given by posting a substantial copy of this election order, in English and Spanish, on the bulletin board at the County Courthouse used for posting notices of Commissioners Court meetings, and at three other public places in the County, not less than 21 days prior to the date set for the election; a substantial copy of this election order, in English and Spanish, also shall be published on the same day in each of two successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County, the date of the first publication to be not more than 30 days and not less than 14 days prior to the date set for the election; a substantial copy of this election order, in English and Spanish, also shall be posted on the date set for the election and during early voting by personal appearance, in a prominent location at each polling place; and a substantial copy of this election order, in English and Spanish, also shall be posted on the County's Internet website, prominently and together with the contents of the proposition, during the 21 days before the date set for the election.

<u>Section 11</u>. In all matters relating to the ordering, giving notice, and holding the election, the County shall comply with the applicable parts of the Texas Election Code, including particularly Chapter 272 of the Texas Election Code pertaining to bilingual requirements and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.

Section 12. It is hereby officially found and determined that notice of the meeting at which this order is adopted was given as required by the Texas Open Meetings Act, and that such meeting has been open to the public at all times when this order was discussed and acted on.

Section 13. This order shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
