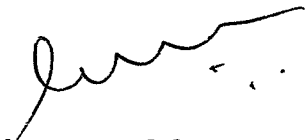

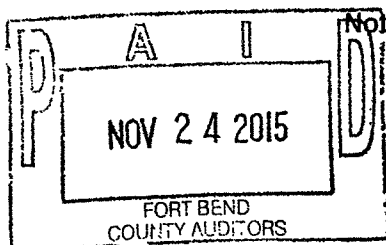

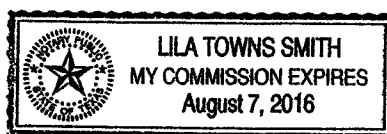

FILM: Sicario

The haunting music, close-quarter combat down a dark tunnel, entrancing character development, unusual camera shots especially from lofty angles, dynamic acting, creative editing, and gripping direction that matched an alluring script; other than that, this movie was a flop.

The duo of Josh Brolin and Benicio Del Toro as government agents who have declared war against a Mexican drug cartel was a smart choice. Props to Director Denis Villeneuve for reaching a sweet balance between these two Hollywood tough guys and the idealistic FBI agent played by Emily Blunt. All three were seemingly the star.

Blunt's costume was a t-shirt, jeans, military-style boots, and a Glock on her right hip. Her Kate was a woman trying to fit-in in a man's world of violence, blood and secret agendas. Here is a taste of the dialogue: "He's off the grid... Kate, this is the future...I'm going to tell everyone what you did - that would be a mistake."

Kate was part of the team, but Josh Brolin treated her like a girl who was skilled with a scoped M4 and a .45 caliber sidearm with an agenda of revenge for the death of her fellow FBI agents.

Del Toro was his usual may-macho mysterious man who might shoot you or save you; he's rarely straight. His portrayal of Alejandro was cagey and measured with a shadowy history in the drug world; it was fun pondering his true identity and motive. That's good writing by screenwriter Taylor Sheridan who was Deputy Chief David Hale on TV's "Sons of Anarchy." The uniting of the two worlds of Sons and Sicario through Sheridan's acting and writing is astonishing. Who is Taylor Sheridan?

For example: Way too much gum chewing. As part of Josh Brolin's persona of being a cagey, unflappable government spook, he often chewed gum. OK, sometimes gum-chewing is appropriate. But, then along comes a character played by Joe Bernalth (Shane Walsh - The Walking Dead) and he's in a bar drinking beer and chewing gum. That's just too much gum gum gum.



This movie was not perfect.

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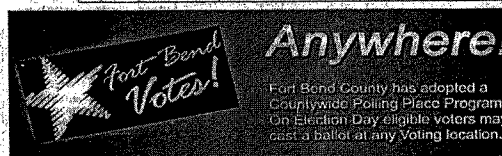

While the proposed amendment would not fully fund the state's overall transportation needs, it would be a key step toward securing critical funding for transportation projects in Texas.

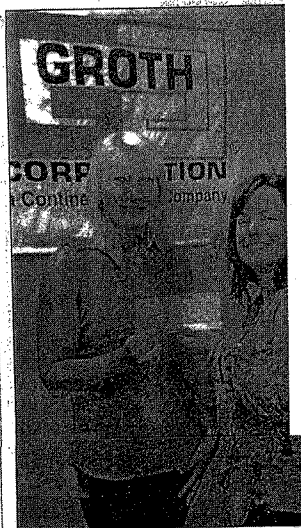
