SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT, is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter "County"), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and Amani Engineering, Inc., (hereinafter "Contractor"), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the parties executed and accepted that certain Agreement for Professional Engineering Services on October 6, 2015, (hereinafter "Agreement") pursuant to SOQ 14-025, as amended on April 26, 2016 (by document hereinafter referred to as "Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to further amend the Agreement for additional services to be provided and increase the total Maximum Compensation for the completion of such additional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

- 1. County shall pay Contractor an additional seventy-five thousand two hundred forty dollars and no/100 (\$75,240.00) to perform the Hydraulic Impact Study as described in the Fee Proposal dated July 27, 2016 attached hereto as Attachment "A" and incorporated herein for all purposes.
- 2. The Maximum Compensation payable to Contractor for Services rendered is hereby increased to an amount not to exceed five hundred thirty-seven thousand eighty-one dollars and no/100 (\$537,081.00), authorized as follows:

\$425,286.00 under the Agreement; \$36,555.00 under the Amendment; and \$75,240.00 under this Second Amendment.

3. In no case shall the amount paid by County for all Services under the Agreement, the Amendment and this Second Amendment exceed the Maximum Compensation without an agreement executed by the parties.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement and the Amendment shall remain unchanged.

Dear Mr. Barnett,

Amani Engineering, Inc. is pleased to provide this revised fee proposal to perform Hydraulic Impact Study for the referenced project. Based on our understanding from the meeting held on 3/23/2016, your e-mail dated 4/5/2016, and our follow up meeting on 5/12/16, we propose the following scope of work, assumptions, exceptions, deliverables, schedule and fee.

I. SCOPE OF WORK:

The scope of services include hydrologic and hydraulic analysis, drainage study for South Post Oak Boulevard from just north of Hunter Green Lane to Trammel Fresno Road, as well as investigate the mitigation requirement for possible future suburban density development of the area east of South Post Oak Boulevard, south of Jasmine Street, west of Kansas Street, and north of Sycamore Road of approximately 150 acres. Refer enclosed Exhibit-A. Amani Engineering will follow City of Houston Infrastructure design manual Chapter 9-Storm water Design Requirements and TP-100 (Design for Storm Sewer General Guidelines) to perform hydraulic impact study.

II. ASSUMPTIONS:

- The project will consist of the construction of a four-lane concrete urban boulevard section from the existing South Post Oak Boulevard; just north of Hunter Green Ln. to the intersection with W. Sycamore Road.
- The concrete boulevard section of South Post Oak Boulevard; will tie into the existing W.
 Sycamore Road as indicated in the enclosed Exhibit B Sample of South Post Oak
 Boulevard W. Sycamore Road Pavement Tie-in.
- There is no anticipated pavement widening to W. Sycamore Road at this time.
 Continuing north a two-lane asphalt road with roadside ditches will be constructed from W. Sycamore Road to Trammel Fresno Road. The two-lane asphalt road will be terminated at the south side of the existing Trammel Fresno Road pavement.
- Right-of-way will be acquired to obtain a 100-foot width where ever it is deficient.
 Anticipated right-of-way is illustrated in the enclosed Exhibit C Anticipated ROW Acquisition Parcels.
- Fort Bend County to purchase additional property at northeast corner of Sycamore / S
 Post Oak Boulevard or at southeast corner of Sycamore / S Post Oak Boulevard to
 provide for the additional detention.
- Master Drainage Plan shall be provided by Fort Bend County for the project area.

SCENARIO FOR DETENTION:

Based on the above assumptions the following design scenario shall be considered.

Additional improvements on the side street ditches and provide detention along southeast corner of W. Sycamore and S. Post Oak Blvd. Refer Exhibit D

- Wetlands Investigations
- Notification to the Texas Historical Commission
- Environmental Site Assessments
- Easement/Off-site Surveys
- SUE Locating Services
- Construction Field Visits and Progress Meetings
- Post Construction Storm Water Management Plan

IV. DELIVERABLES:

Hydraulic Impact Study Report which includes the following items:

- 1. Project Drainage area map, existing drainage infrastructure and outfall information.
- 2. Analyze existing system (road side ditches) for a 2 year and 100 year event using HouStorm.
- 3. Overland flow paths using readily available data such as LiDAR for more accurate determination of ponded areas and flow directions.
- 4. 2 year storm sewer proposed design with new &/or improved storm sewers and/or inlets.
- 5. Determine if regional detention or local real-estate is available for mitigation.
- 6. 100-year impact analysis.
- 7. Identify mitigation measures and overland flow improvements.
- 8. Produce Hydraulic data sheets, drainage area maps, and all applicable storm sewer preliminary design documents.

V. SCHEDULE:

8 weeks from Notice to Proceed to Submit Hydraulic Impact Study report.

VI. FEE:

As detailed in enclosed Level of Effort Estimate, we propose a lump sum fee of \$75,240.00

EXHIBIT B SAMPLE OF S. POST OAK BLVD. – W. SYCAMORE ROAD PAVEMENT TIE-IN



ANTICIPATED ROW ACQUISITION PARCELS




