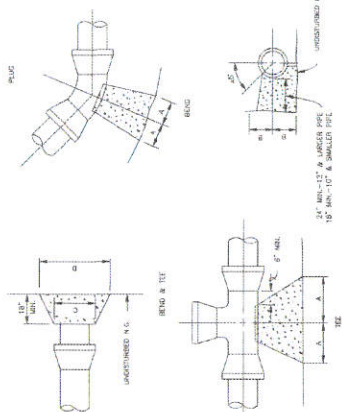
EXTERNAL DROP CONNECTION DETAIL



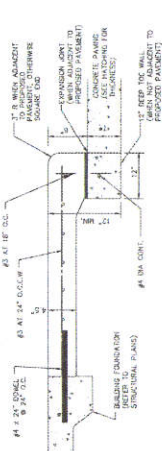
