Tuition, CLE, and Eligibility Information

CLE: Anticipated CLE credits, including at least one Ethics hour, will be approximately 18.

NDAA will apply for CLE credit in Virginia, Ohio, Tennessee and the state in which this course is being held. All other states will require the attorney to self-submit using their uniform certificate of attendance.

Eligibility: Open to lawyers in local, state, tribal, federal and military government attorneys' offices, paralegals who work in these offices and law enforcement officers who work on narcotics cases.

Course Tuition is \$525.00 for Members, which includes admission and course materials, \$625 for Non-Members.
