**SIXTH AMENDMENT TO  
PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT**

**THIS SIXTH AMENDMENT**, is made and entered into by and between Fort Bend County (hereinafter "County"), a body corporate and politic under the laws of the State of Texas, and SES Horizon Consulting Engineers, Inc., (hereinafter "Engineer"), a company authorized to conduct business in the State of Texas.

WHEREAS, the parties executed and accepted that certain Professional Engineering Services Agreement on June 10, 2008, (hereinafter "Agreement"), a First Amendment dated February 2, 2010, (hereinafter "First Amendment"), a Second Amendment dated September 6, 2011, (hereinafter "Second Amendment"), a Third Amendment dated May 7, 2013, (hereinafter "Third Amendment"), a Fourth Amendment dated April 7, 2015, (hereinafter "Fourth Amendment"); and a Fifth Amendment dated December 1, 2015, (hereinafter "Fifth Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to further amend the Agreement for additional services to be provided and increase the total Maximum Compensation for the completion of such additional services.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

1. County shall pay Engineer an additional twenty-one thousand five hundred seventy dollars and no/100 (\$21,570.00) for the additional Professional Engineering and Technical Services – Construction Phase Close Out and Construction Inspection Services as described in the formal request for authorization dated September 8, 2016 attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein for all purposes.
2. The Maximum Compensation payable to Engineer for Services rendered is hereby increased to an amount not to exceed one million seventy-eight thousand two hundred forty dollars and 25/100 (\$1,078,240.25), authorized as follows:

\$650,000.00 under the Agreement;  
\$0.00 under the First Amendment (time extension only);  
\$41,000.00 under the Second Amendment;  
\$99,437.00 under the Third Amendment;  
\$182,142.00 under the Fourth Amendment;  
\$84,091.25 under the Fifth Amendment; and  
\$21,570.00 under this Sixth Amendment.

3. In no case shall the amount paid by County for all Services under the Agreement and the subsequent amendments thereof exceed the Maximum Compensation without further amendment.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement and the subsequent Amendments shall remain unchanged.

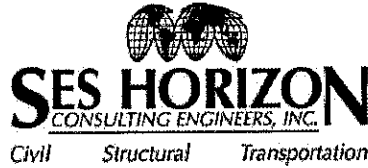

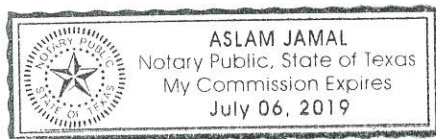
