This 10-day course focuses on supervisory management practices as they relate to Emergency Medical Services (EMS) in the fire service. This interactive and fast-moving course will enable participants to deal more effectively with day-to-day management issues that supervisory-level managers are likely to encounter. Personnel, resource management, and quality improvement techniques are some of the major components of this course. Upon completion of this course, the students will be able to enhance the quality and overall effectiveness of their EMS operation through the use of management techniques.

Individuals with midlevel management responsibility for an EMS delivery system (battalion/division chief, captain, shift supervisor).

Prerequisites
