Re: Final Plat for Camellia Amenities Reserve – Variance Request

On behalf of Victorian Gardens, Ltd. (developer of Camellia subdivision) we have submitted the final plat for Camellia Amenities Reserve to Fort Bend County for consideration and approval at the next available Commissioners Court Meeting. This final plat has been approved by the City of Houston.

We request a variance to the Fort Bend County Subdivision standard (Section 5.12.C.1) of a 25-foot front building line in order to allow a 15-foot building line along a portion of Camellia Gardens Drive . The building line variance request is due to the size of the proposed swimming pool and the proposed recreational building and the need to situate all improvements away from the edge of the existing sand pit. This solution is depicted in the attached drawing.
