

**ORDER APPOINTING A PERSON TO FILL A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF
JUDGE OF FORT BEND COUNTY COURT AT LAW NO. 4**

On this day there came to be considered by the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas, the matter of an appointment of a person to fill a vacancy in the office of Judge of Fort Bend County Court at Law No. 4.

WHEREAS, the death of the Honorable R. H. "Sandy" Bielstein created a vacancy in the office of Judge of Fort Bend County Court at Law No. 4; and

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code §25.0009 requires the Commissioners Court to appoint a person to fill a vacancy in the office of Judge of a statutory county court; and

WHEREAS, the appointee shall hold the office of Judge until the next general election and until the successor is elected and has qualified; and

WHEREAS, _____ meets the minimum standards to serve as a County Court at Law Judge under Texas Government Code Section 25.0014; and

WHEREAS, Texas Government Code §25.0006 and §26.001 requires each judge of a statutory county court to execute a bond that is payable to the treasurer of the county in an amount not more than \$10,000 that must be approved by Commissioners Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, Fort Bend County Commissioners Court through a majority vote hereby appoints _____ to serve as Judge of Fort Bend County Court at Law No. 4, effective upon subscribing to the official oath of office and delivery of a bond payable to Jeff Council, Fort Bend County Treasurer, or his successors in office securing faithful performance of his/her duties to fulfill the vacancy of judge and the unexpired term of the Honorable R. H. "Sandy" Bielstein, until the next general election and the successor is elected and has qualified.
