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Re: Approval of Bonds for CHI St. Luke's Health System

Gentlemen:

On behalf of our client, CHI St. Luke's Health System Corporation, we respectfully request that the Commissioners Court consider readopting the enclosed resolution (the "2017 Resolution") to permit the issuance of tax-exempt limited obligation revenue bonds to finance and refinance the acquisition, construction, renovation, and equipping of certain facilities described in the enclosed notice of public hearing and located in Fort Bend County, Texas. The Commissioners Court passed a similar resolution on June 28, 2016 (the "2016 Resolution"). However, because the bonds will not be used within a year after passage and facilities may be financed at an additional location, renewal of the Commissioners Court's prior approval by passage of the 2017 Resolution is a condition to tax-exempt financing of the facilities.

We enclose (a) six (6) copies of the proposed 2017 Resolution, (b) a notice of a public hearing on the bonds and the facilities, which was published in the *Houston Chronicle* on June 2, 2017, and describes the facilities now to be financed and refinanced by the bonds, (c) a blacklined comparison of the notice of public hearing to a 2016 notice of public hearing that described the facilities previously approved by the Commissioners Court, and (d) a certificate reporting that no one appeared at the public hearing described in the updated notice to oppose the bonds or facilities.

We would suggest that this matter appear separately on the agenda for the Commissioners Court meeting as follows:

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE AND REFINANCE CERTAIN PROJECTS FOR CHI ST. LUKE'S HEALTH SYSTEM

CHI St. Luke's Health System is part of the much larger Catholic Health Initiatives (CHI) health system and therefore able to enjoy economics of scale, including in its financings. The bonds would be issued by the Colorado Health Facilities Authority as part of a larger financing of other CHI facilities in other states. As we have previously reported, section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, provides that bonds to finance facilities in Fort Bend County must be approved by the Commissioners Court, the County Judge, or another governmental unit or official with jurisdiction, after a public hearing held on public notice, in order

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for interest on the bonds to be exempt from federal income taxes. As noted by the enclosed certificate, a public hearing for this purpose will be held next week. We therefore request that the Commissioners Court adopt the enclosed resolution to enable an efficient financing and refinancing of facilities for CHI St. Luke's Health System and its affiliates, including CHI St. Luke's Health Baylor College of Medicine Medical Center.

Also enclosed with the copy of this letter are six (6) copies of a Certificate of County Clerk relating to the resolution. We request that the County Clerk return five (5) fully executed Certificates after adoption of the enclosed resolution.

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS TO FINANCE AND REFINANCE CERTAIN PROJECTS FOR CHI ST. LUKE'S HEALTH SYSTEM

WHEREAS, pursuant to 26 U.S.C. §147(f), as amended (hereinafter referred to as "Section 147(f) of the Code"), after reasonable public notice (a copy of which is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**), a public hearing has been conducted on the issuance of its limited obligation revenue bonds (hereinafter referred to as the "Bonds") by the Colorado Health Facilities Authority, the interest of which is intended to be excluded from gross income for federal income tax purposes, to finance, refinance, pay, or reimburse the costs of expenditures made for the acquisition, construction, renovation, and equipping of certain capital projects described in such notice, including facilities (hereinafter referred to as the "Projects") located in Fort Bend County, Texas (the "County"), all of which are owned, operated, managed or otherwise used by CHI St. Luke's Health System Corporation, a Texas non-profit corporation, or one or more affiliates as described in such notice; and

WHEREAS, the approval of the Bonds and the Projects by a governmental unit having jurisdiction over the area in which the Projects are located is a condition to the exclusion of interest on the Bonds from the gross income of the owners thereof for federal income tax purposes and, consequently, is necessary to finance and refinance the Projects at the favorable interest rates which are currently borne by tax-exempt obligations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT:

- 1. The issuance of a portion of the Bonds in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$235,000,000 million to finance and refinance the Projects, as well as the appointment of the person to hold the above-described public hearing, are hereby approved pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Code.
- 2. The approval herein granted is solely for purposes of Section 147(f) of the Code and shall not be construed as a representation, warranty, or other undertaking of any kind by the County in respect of the Bonds or the Projects. The Bonds shall not constitute obligations of the State of Texas, this County, or any other political subdivision or agency thereof, or a pledge of the faith and credit of any of them. Neither the State of Texas nor any political subdivision thereof, including this County, shall be obligated to pay the Bonds or the interest thereon. Neither the faith and credit nor the taxing power of the State of Texas, this County, or any other political subdivision or agency thereof shall be pledged to the payment of principal of, redemption premium, if any, or interest on the Bonds.
- 3. The County Judge, the County Commissioners, and the County Clerk and other officers of the County, or any of them, are hereby authorized to execute and deliver such endorsements, certificates, instruments, documents, or other papers and to do all other things necessary or advisable to give effect to the intent and purpose hereof.

Following the public hearing a report concerning the hearing will be submitted to such Commissioners Courts and/or County Judges with a request to approve the issuance of the Bonds and the facilities.
