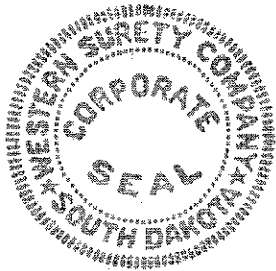
AND WHEREAS, the principal desires to provide Fort Bend County with a performance

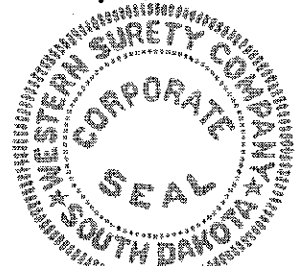

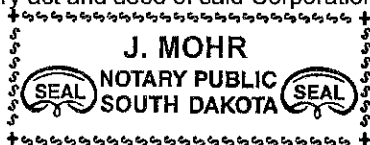



and agrees that this project meets with minimum requirements of this department or office. The following comments may need to be addressed or observed.

The construction plans propose to construct a berm to minimize potential impacts associated with Brazos River flood events. The proposed design includes features to ensure that Long Point Creek flood plain storage is not impacted during local rain events. The plans propose an opening along the berm that will allow Long Point Creek flood events to enter the site but will be sealed with a 90' long, 5' diameter flood tube during major Brazos River flood events. Sheet C3.0 "Flood Tube Notes" specifically state that the flood tube shall only be deployed during a major Brazos River flood event, shall be removed once the water level has receded, and the residents of the subject tract shall be responsible for deploying, removing, repairing, and maintaining the proposed flood tube. Sheet C3.0 notes that all work within the McKeever Rd. right-of-way must be coordinated with, and permitted through, the Fort Bend County Road & Bridge Department prior to construction. FBCDD approval is contingent upon the attached "Certificate of Completion" being completed and returned to the FBCDD once construction of the project is complete.

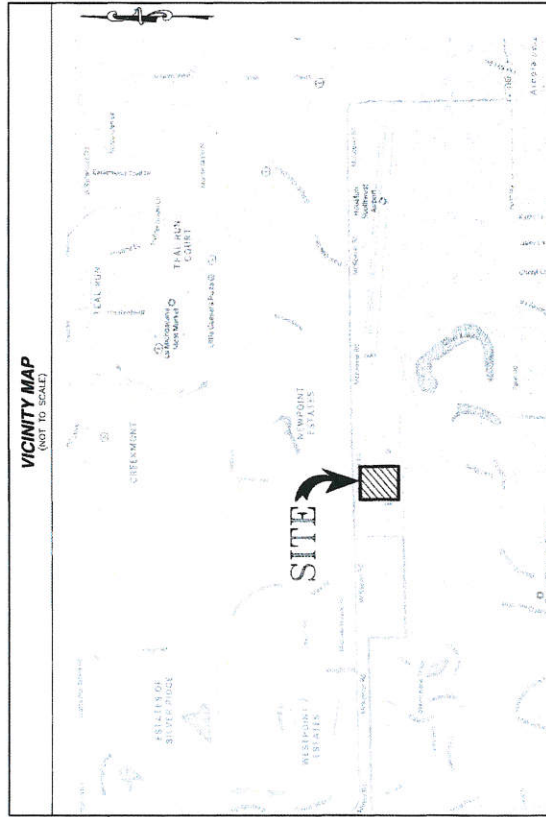
