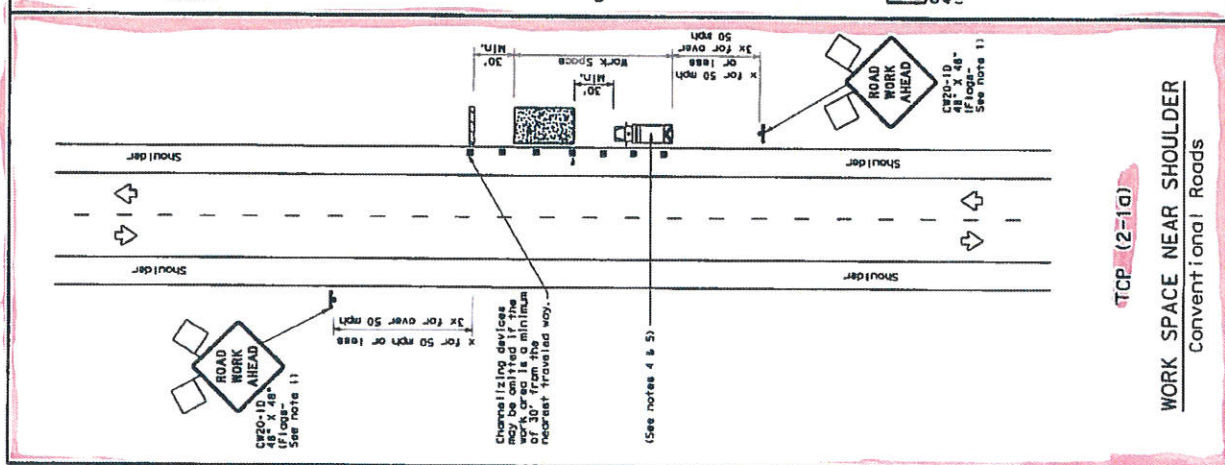

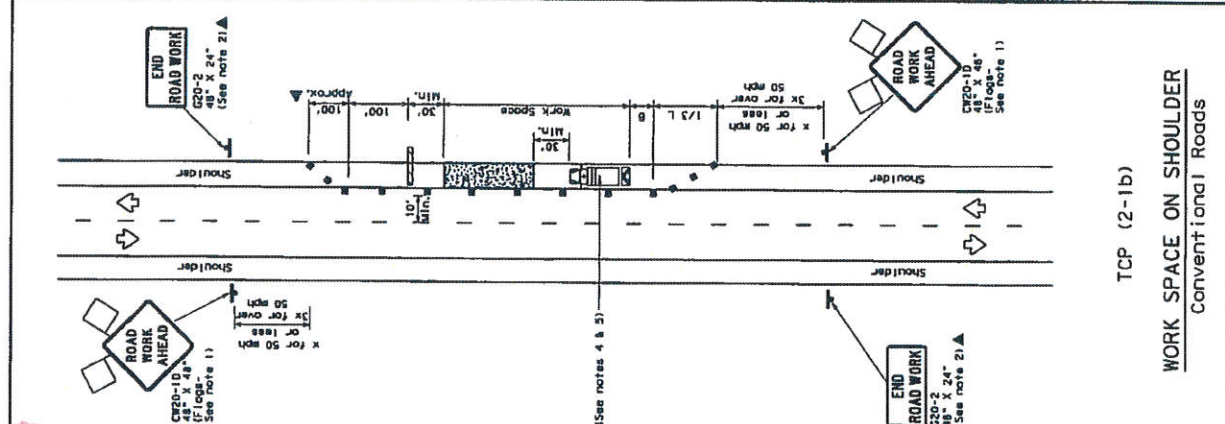

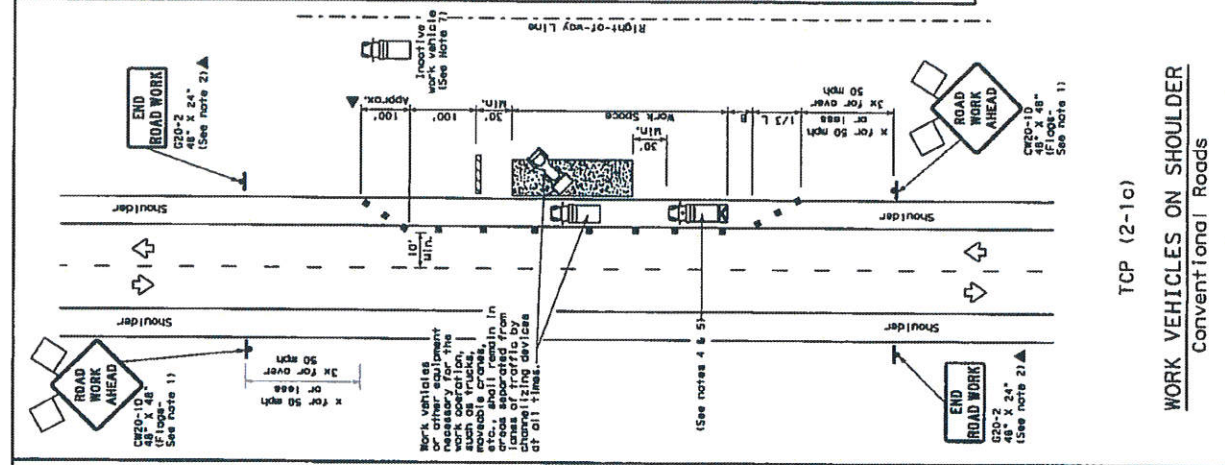

GENERAL NOTES

- Flags attached to signs where shown, are REQUIRED.
- All traffic control devices (illustrated) are REQUIRED, except those denoted with the Triangle symbol may be omitted when stated in the project GENERAL NOTES for Item 502, Barricades, Signs and Traffic Handling.
- Shoulder material should be placed a minimum of 30 feet from nearest traveled way.
- Shovel vehicles with low and high intensity rotating, flashing, oscillating arrow lights, & shovel vehicles with a TMA should be used to maintain the work area. The TMA should be placed in the area of the work area without adversely affecting the performance or quality of the work. If workers are no longer present but road or work conditions require the traffic control to remain in place, Type 3 Barricades or other channelizing devices may be used.
- Additional Shoulder Vehicles with TMA may be positioned off the paved surface, next to those shown in order to protect a wider work area.
- See TCEM-11 for shoulder work on divided highways, expressways and interchanges.
- Inactive work vehicles or other equipment should be parked near the right-of-way line and not parked on the paved shoulder.
- CP21-5 "SHOULDER WORK" signs may be used in place of CP21-10 "ROAD WORK AHEAD" signs for shoulder work on conventional roadways.

For construction or maintenance contract work, specific project requirements for shoulder vehicles can be found in the project GENERAL NOTES for Item 502, Barricades, Signs and Traffic Handling.
