RE: Sweetgrass Circle in Del Webb Richmond – “SPEED LIMIT 30”

Dear Commissioner Morales:

Fort Bend County Engineering Department has completed the traffic control plan to place a speed limit of 30 miles per hour on Sweetgrass Circle within the Del Webb-Richmond subdivision, as shown on the traffic control plan. The road currently has a speed limit of 35 mph and a 28-foot cross-section with several pedestrian crossings at uncontrolled intersections. Given the characteristics of the roadway, and a recent speed study that revealed an 85th percentile speed of 32 mph, Engineering recommends lowering the speed limit on Sweetgrass Circle to 30 mph. The public hearing date for acceptance for the plan will be scheduled on the next available Commissioner's Court Agenda.

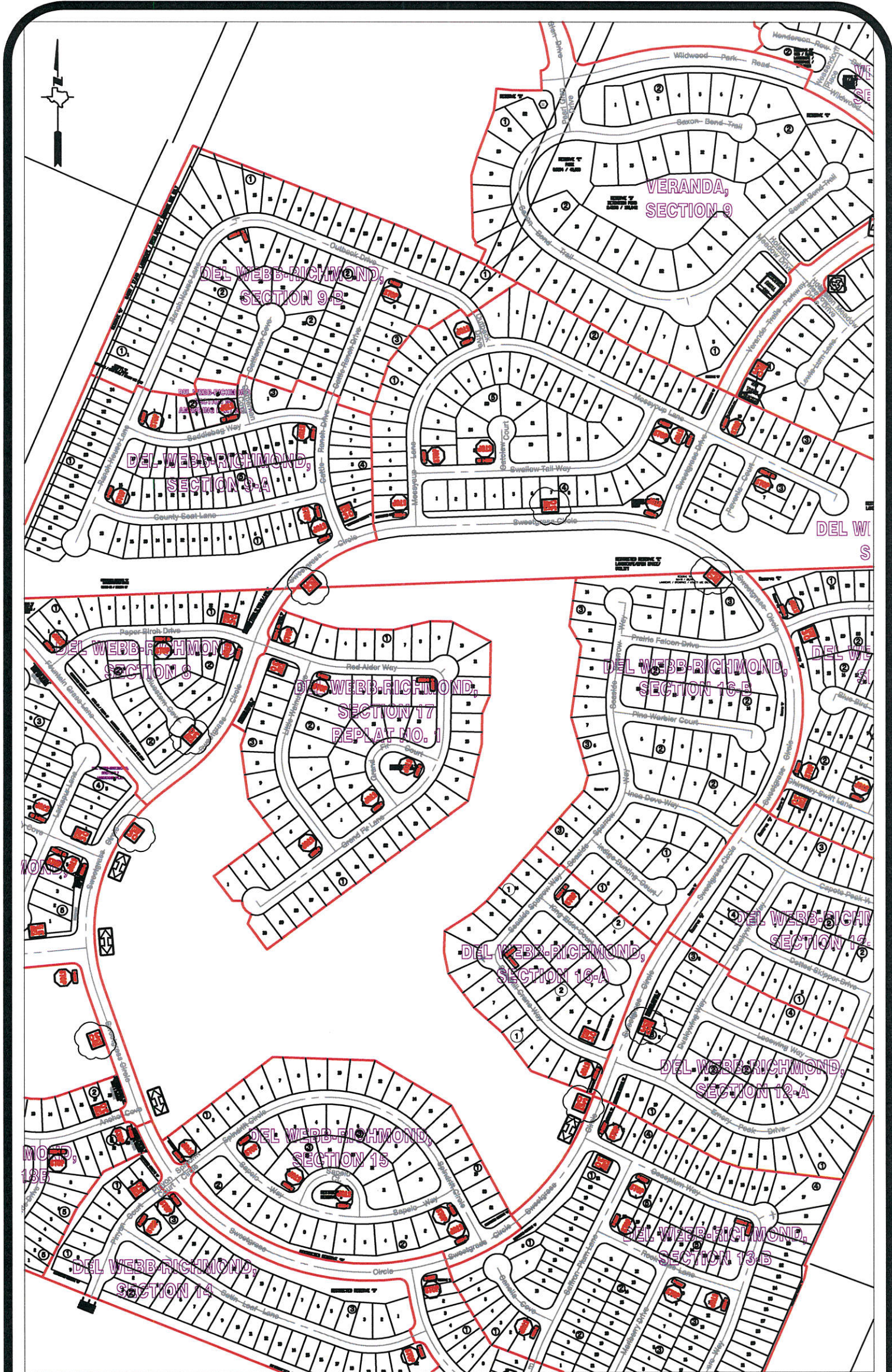
