SECOND EXTENSION OF LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER DECLARATION FORT BEND COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER

WHEREAS, on the <u>24th</u> day of <u>August, 2017</u>, the County Judge issued a proclamation declaring a local state of disaster for Fort Bend County, Texas, resulting from the threat of imminent disaster from **Tropical Storm (Hurricane) Harvey**; and

WHEREAS, on the <u>29th</u> day of <u>August</u>, <u>2017</u>, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, as its governing body, continued the Order of a local state of disaster for an additional fourteen (14) days, effective on <u>August 29</u>, <u>2017</u> as authorized by §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code;

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating the declaration of a local state of disaster continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, a declaration of local disaster may not be continued or renewed for a period of more than seven days except with the consent of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, as its governing body, desires to continue the order of a local state of disaster for an additional twenty-eight (28) days pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT of FORT BEND COUNTY:

- 1. That the local state of disaster ordered for Fort Bend County, Texas, by the County Judge on <u>August 24, 2017</u> and continued by order of the Fort Bend County Commissioners Court on <u>August 29, 2017</u> shall further continue for an additional twenty-eight (28) days through <u>October 10, 2017</u>.
- 2. This order is passed as an emergency measure pursuant §418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code and shall become effective on the **September 12, 2017**.
