RE: Creation of School Zone and addition of "NO LEFT TURN" and "NO U-TURN" signs on Mason Road, University Park Drive, and Camden Bend Lane

Dear Commissioner Meyers:

The Katy Independent School District is temporarily holding classes for Creech Elementary School at the UH-Cinco Ranch campus on University Park Drive due to damage sustained to Creech Elementary during Hurricane Harvey. In order to accommodate the school traffic and improve safety for drivers and pedestrians in the area, Fort Bend County Engineering recommends the creation of a School Zone on Mason Road and University Park Drive, as well as "No Left Turn" signs on all four approaches of the Mason Road at University Park Drive / Camden Bend Lane intersection, and "No U-Turn" signs on northbound Mason Road at median openings between University Park Drive and Westheimer Parkway. The School Zone and all turning prohibitions will be in effect on weekdays from 7:50 – 8:50 a.m. and 3:10 – 4:10 p.m. The public hearing date for acceptance for the plan will be scheduled on the next available Commissioner's Court Agenda.
