NOTICE OF INTENT

TAKE NOTICE that the Commissioners Court of Fort Bend County, Texas (the "County") shall convene at 1:00 pm on September 28, 2017, at its regular meeting place at the County Courthouse, 403 Jackson St., Richmond, Texas, of said County and during such meeting, the Commissioners Court will consider the passage of an order authorizing the issuance of certificates of obligation in an amount not to exceed \$6,000,000 for the purpose of paying contractual obligations to be incurred (1) for the purpose of evidencing the indebtedness of the County to pay all or any part of the contractual obligations incurred to acquire, construct, equip, retrofit, repair, renovate, rehabilitate and/or install equipment, machinery, and improvements (including HVAC) to enhance and improve energy efficiency of certain systems of buildings and public works of the County

that constitute a "Qualified Conservation Purpose" within the meaning of Section 54D(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended and (2) for professional services. The certificates of obligation will be payable from the levy of an annual ad valorem tax, within the limits prescribed by law, upon taxable property within the County and from a pledge of net revenues derived from the operation of the County's payment system.

The certificates of obligation are issued, and this notice given, under and pursuant to the provisions of Texas Local Government Code, Section 271.049, as amended.
