Re: Extension of Interlocal Agreement between City of Houston and Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office - Houston-Metro Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force Program

Dear Sheriff Nehls:

The City of Houston and the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office (FBSO) entered into an Interlocal Agreement on October 3, 2017, providing for use of grant funds received from the State of Texas Governor's Office Criminal Justice Division (CJD) to participate in the Houston-Metro Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force.

The Agreement authorizes the Chief of Police for the Houston Police Department to extend the Agreement if grant funds continue to be available. It was agreed that any application for additional grant funds above those amounts shown in Exhibit A shall first be approved by the Houston Police Department and FBSO and be in accordance with the effective Grant Application and Administration Guidelines of the CJD.

CJD grant funds are available to extend the Interlocal Agreement through **February 28, 2019**. The available grant funding will be utilized to pay for personnel costs, a leased vehicle and fuel for the Fort Bend County Sheriff's Office for one additional year beginning **March 1, 2018**, as listed on the revised Exhibit A attached to this letter.
