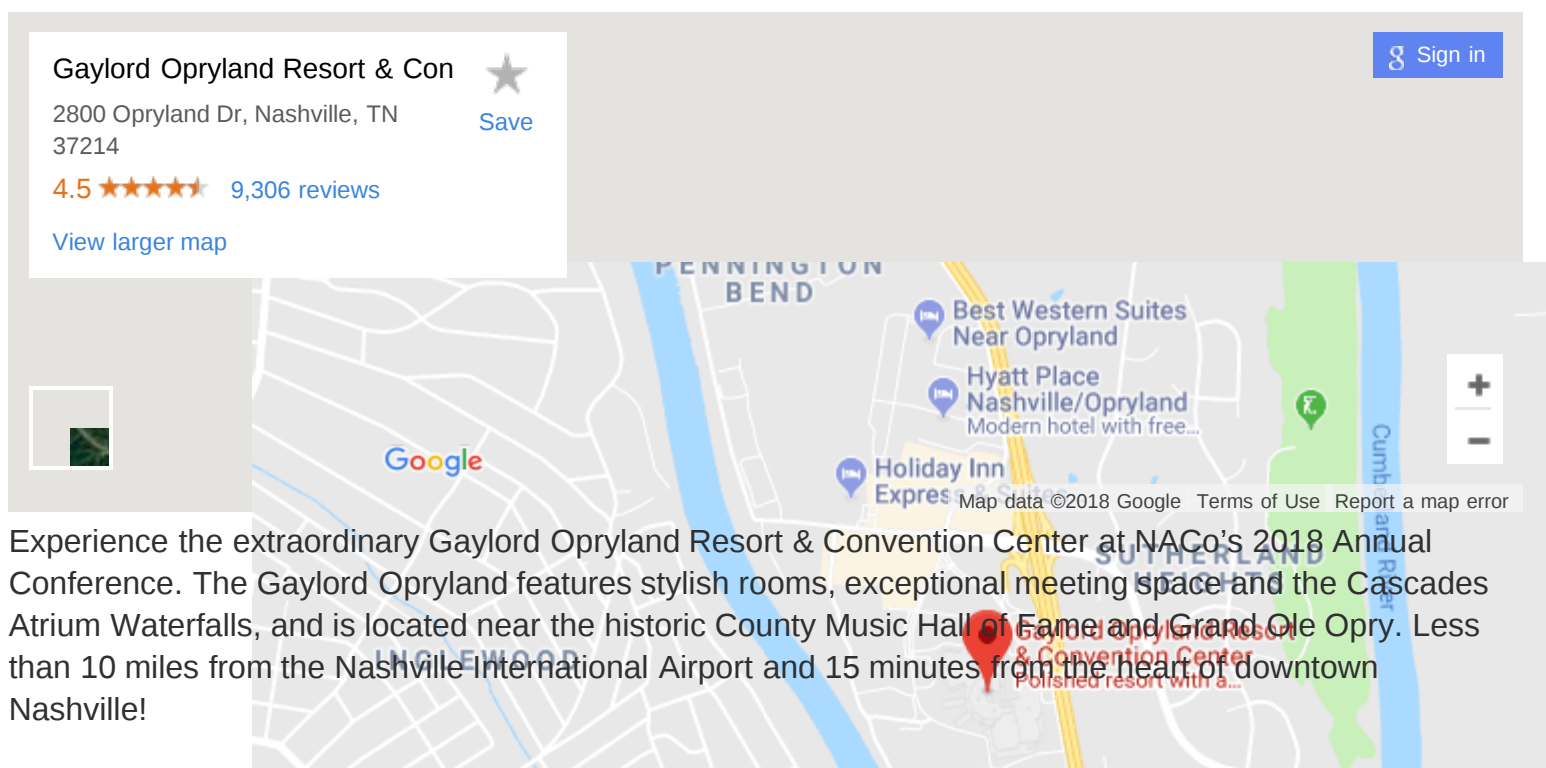

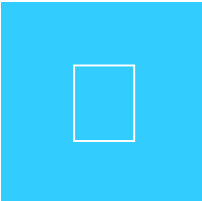
NACo has negotiated reduced hotel rates for Annual Conference attendees starting at \$184 per night plus applicable taxes and fees.

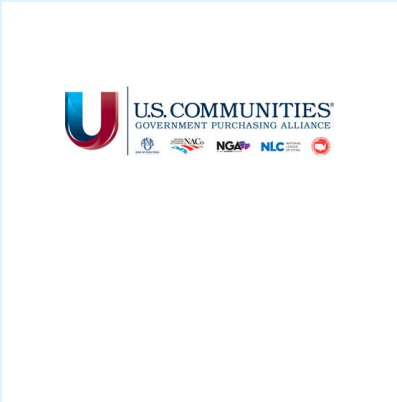
