1. Flagger should use two-way radios or other methods of communication to control traffic.

2. Length of work space should be based on the ability of Flagger to communicate.

3. If the work space is located near a horizontal or vertical curve, the buffer distances should be increased in order to maintain adequate stopping sight distance to the flagger.

4. Channelizing devices on the center-line may be omitted when a pilot car is leading traffic and approved by the Engineer.

5. Flagger should maintain adequate positions to control traffic. Flagger should be positioned to observe approaching traffic.
