* What will be the impact of this Currently we use topical flea/tick preventative on intake but for the pets whose length of stay sometimes exceeds 90 days, we need something else to protect them, particularly during the tick season in Texas. Being able to provide flea/tick medication for our pets who stay with us long-term improves their health and wellbeing as well as improves their adoption chances. While we do treat the kennels and grounds, we do not have the budget to treat individual pets over time.
