# APPLYING FOR FUNDING

## Who will receive funding from the Rebuild Texas Fund?

Funding through the Rebuild Texas Fund will be provided to eligible nonprofit, government, and philanthropic organizations working on the ground in Texas communities, big and small, that have been affected by Hurricane Harvey. The fund will support organizations that provide services in six focus areas – community and economic development; health; housing; education and childcare; transportation and workforce; and capital for rebuilding small businesses.

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY \*

Harvey Preparedness Grant Round - During large scale disasters when many people are displaced from their homes and find themselves in need of shelter, local governments work internally and with external partners to set up shelters to provide safety, food, and comfort until the crisis has diminished. More and more, local governments are finding that not only are shelters needed to support the general population, but that medical shelters are needed as well. Medical shelters provide skilled nursing care for those individuals who may have been receiving that level of care in their homes.

## NEED / PROBLEM STATEMENT \*

Many individuals who seek shelter and have medical needs require medical grade oxygen. Clients may have evacuated their homes without their medical equipment or their equipment may have been too badly damaged to be of use. Local entities operating medical shelters need access to medical equipment immediately as the crises unfolds.

## PROJECT DESCRIPTION \*

Fort Bend County Health & Human Services will acquire twenty (20) mobile portable oxygen concentrators to support medical needs shelter clients. These concentrators will support medical sheltering operations and provide life sustaining oxygen to clients with chronic medical conditions. Each device can support one individual at a time, but can be used for multiple clients over time as individuals move from shelters and become self sufficient. These concentrators will assist many clients over many years and multiple disasters.

The project can be initiated upon approval of Commissioner's Court once the grant funds have been approved by Rebuild Texas.
