The Industrial Development Corporation of La Paz County, Arizona Education Facilities Lease Revenue Bonds (Charter School Solutions), Series 2018 (the "Bonds")

Judge Hebert:

Charter School Solutions is requesting your approval of a proposed tax-exempt bond issue, as required by the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"). The Bonds will not be a debt or liability of Fort Bend County, Texas (the "County"). The consent being requested herein is only for the purposes of complying with federal tax law regarding tax-exempt financing.

Charter School Solutions is a qualified 501(c)(3) organization and therefore is eligible to participate in tax-exempt financings. However, unlike a governmental issuer (city, county, and school district), a 501(c)(3) organization issues bonds through a state-approved conduit and must conduct a hearing on the financing. Because there is at least one campus located in Fort Bend County, Texas (the "County"), Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code, requires that the "highest elected official" of the County approve the transaction after a public hearing is held. The public hearing was held, and you will find attached with this letter a copy of the sworn affidavit from the hearing officer.

Charter School Solutions is financing and refinancing the construction and equipment of their schools across the State of Texas. Charter School Solutions is financing at tax-exempt interest rates through a bond issue facilitated by the Industrial Development Authority of the County of La Paz, Arizona. Hunton Andrews Kurth LLP serves as bond counsel for the transaction.

As such, we respectfully request your consent to the transaction. Attached is a copy of the Certificate of County Judge and the Certificate of Hearing Officer. We are still waiting on the Affidavit of Publication from the Houston Chronicle and will follow up with that as soon as we receive it.
