The County is a direct recipient of FY2017 5310 funds allocated by METRO as the designated recipient. The Houston METRO split letter allocates \$1,052,376 to FBC of which all will be used in this grant.

Project Description

Fort Bend County is requesting purchase of service funding from the FY2017 Section 5310 Elderly and Disabled program in the amount of \$1,052,376 as approved in TIP Amendment #12(MPOID 11790) to maintain current service levels.

Project Benefits

Fort Bend County Public Transportation Department (FBCPT) provides general public demand response, deviated fixed route and commuter services. Elderly and disabled demand response services are part of our overall project as well as through an agreement with Fort Bend Seniors Meals on Wheels.

For general transportation, seniors must book their trips like any other individual seeking a ride. Reservations can be made up to 30 days in advance or no later than one (1) business day in advance. Reservations are accepted Monday through Friday between 8 am and 5 pm, excluding Holidays. Trips are scheduled Monday through Friday for first drop off by 8 am and last pick-up at 5 pm, excluding Holidays. General trip fare is \$1.00 per person each way. This service is curb to curb; however, door to door service is available to those with disabilities upon request.

Fort Bend Seniors Meals on Wheels is a non-profit agency in which we continue to coordinate with. Fort Bend Seniors clients benefit by being able to utilize a transportation system that meet their needs. Fort Bend Seniors Meals on Wheels provides a portion of the costs for the clients transit needs so the seniors are not charged fares for their trips to the Senior Centers.

Additional Information

FBCPT does not directly operate services. All services are provided via a third0party contract for bus services.

Extended Budget Description

Fort Bend County has a 3rd party contract with First Transit to provide demand response transportation services. TDC's have been approved in the amount of \$210,475 in lieu of local match.

Purchase of service for services eligible under 5310 is eligible under the traditional capital 5310 program at 80/20 of the contract cost (FTA Circular 9070.1G, p. III-11, part "e.") . e. Acquisition of transportation services under a contract, lease, or other arrangement.
